Cynthia's studies with Mary Burmeister began in 1985. Following that first class she began working hands-on with her daughter's roommates at hospital, and in her 25 years of practice she's worked with people of all ages and states of health. She has taught Self-Help Classes for twenty years and has been presenting Jin Shin Jyutsu 5-Day Seminars and Special Topic Classes internationally since 2002.. Her creative work as a visual artist and poet clarifies and colours her teaching.

Special Topic Class - Critical Ages and All-Combined Timing

In this Special Topic Class we will get to know **Page 42 - Text 2 - Disharmony occurring according to age (critical)**, which simplifies and deepens my understanding of chronic and critical projects. This page relates the cause of a critical project to the "individualizing" of the Universal Blueprint in the womb, helping me to understand the origins and harmonizers of any big label.

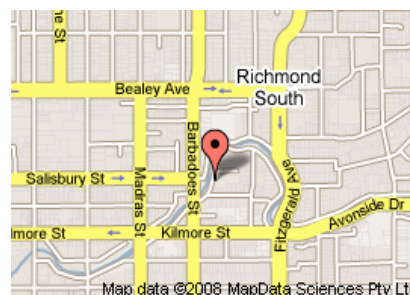
